

**RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATIVE TO
THE PLACING OF LETTERS AND NUMBERS
ON STATE OF RHODE ISLAND GRAPHIC REGISTRATION PLATES**

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of these rules is to formally establish the policy of the Division of Motor Vehicles of the Rhode Island Department of Transportation concerning the placement of letters and/or numbers on State of Rhode Island graphic registration plates that depict a sailboat on the design.

II. SCOPE

These regulations apply to all such registration plates that shall be issued by the State of Rhode Island.

III. AUTHORITY

These rules and regulations are adopted pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws, Section 31-2-4 and 31-3-11.

IV. POLICY ON PLACEMENT OF NUMBERS AND/OR LETTERS ON STATE OF RHODE ISLAND GRAPHIC REGISTRATION PLATES

Letters and/or numbers shall be placed on State of Rhode Island graphic registration plates that depict a sailboat in the design as below described:

PASSENGER REGISTRATION PLATES:

ONE NUMERAL	PHOTO A
TWO NUMERALS	PHOTO B
THREE NUMERALS	PHOTO C
FOUR NUMERALS	PHOTO D
FIVE NUMERALS	EXPLANATION E
ONE LETTER & ONE NUMERAL	PHOTO G
ONE LETTER & TWO NUMERALS	PHOTO H

PASSENGER REGISTRATION PLATES (Cont'd)

ONE LETTER & THREE NUMERALS	PHOTO I
TWO LETTERS & ONE NUMERAL	PHOTO J
TWO LETTERS & TWO NUMERALS	PHOTO K
TWO LETTERS & THREE NUMERALS	PHOTO L

COMMERCIAL REGISTRATION PLATES:

Commercial registration plates shall be labeled with the word “commercial” at the bottom in place of the words Ocean State as shown in Photo F. Commercial registration plates shall contain only numbers from one number to six numbers as displayed in Photos A, B, C, D, E and F.

Additional slashes, lines or dots will not be embossed, printed, painted or in any way placed on these registrations plates.



