

SUBJECT: Promulgation of regulation.

In conjunction with 31-23-47 of the General Laws, entitled, Equipment and Accessories Generally, the following regulation is promulgated:

The, "Slow Moving Vehicle," emblem complies with the standards that have been approved and adopted by the American Society of Agricultural Engineers and the Society of Automotive Engineers. The emblem should be permanently mounted, point up, in a plane perpendicular to the direction of travel. It should be located centrally at the rear of the vehicle, with the lower edge of the emblem between 2 feet and 6 feet from the ground. This emblem should be unobscured and should not obstruct any lamp or signal device.
