

3. The name, address, telephone number, age and experience of all people who will be assisting the pyrotechnician/permittee at the display site.

4. The specific date and time on which the display will be held. Include rain date(s) where applicable.

5. The manner and place of storage of the fireworks prior to the display. In case of cancellation, inclement weather or situations in which shells remain unfired, a licensed magazine must be used for temporary storage. Please list the name, address and telephone number of the licensed magazine.

6. Attach a copy of the certificate of insurance. The certificate must be clearly legible.

7. A detailed site plan/diagram must be submitted showing the point at which the fireworks are to be discharged; the location of all nearby buildings, highways and other lines of communication; the lines behind which the audience will be restrained and the location of nearby trees, telephone lines and overhead obstruction. Please indicate the approximate distance from the discharge site.

8. List the quantity, type and size of fireworks to be discharged.

9. List the quantity, type and size of the extinguishers, which will be available at the time of the display. Also, list the amount of safe-line tape you will have available if needed. Sandbags should be available as well as a pickaxe and a shovel.

10. Either attach a copy of your Federal (ATF) explosives permit/license or list the permit/number and date of expiration.

11. Either attach a copy of your RI permit to transport Class "B" explosives or list the decal number, make of vehicle and license plate number of the vehicle. Department of Transportation placards must be displayed on the vehicle while transporting Class "B" explosives.

12. If the display is to be conducted from City property, a permit must be obtained from the Parks Department. Please attach a copy of the Parks Department permit.

13. It is the responsibility of the permittee to obtain an entertainment license for fireworks from the Board of Licenses in the respective city or town. This license may be obtained after this application is completed and approved by a member of the Fire Department so designated by the Chief of Fire Department or the Fire Marshal to approve fireworks permits.

14. The person to whom a permit has been issued shall arrange for the detailing of one member of the Fire Department in the respective city or town or such larger number as may be deemed necessary by the Fire Marshal or Chief of the Fire Department. The expense for such firefighter(s) shall be paid by the permittee. The permittee shall also be responsible for contacting the local Police Department to make any and all arrangements for police details.

15. NFPA 1123, *Code for Fireworks Display*, must be complied with to the fullest extent.

16. By affixing your signature to this application, you acknowledge that all of the information you have provided is accurate. You also acknowledge that you have read and understood all of the requirements set down in the Rhode Island Fire Safety Code, Section 11 entitled "The Keeping, Using, Transporting and Storage of Commercial Fireworks", and Title 23, Chapter 28.11 of the Rhode Island General Laws entitled "Fireworks and Pyrotechnics".
