LIMITED PREMISE LICENSE/CLASS C AND LIMITED MAINTENANCE LICENSE/CLASS D

ALL LIMITED PREMISES AND LIMITED MAINTENANCE LICENSES ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND TRAINING/DIVISION OF PROFESSIONAL REGULATION SHALL INCLUDE A DESCRIPTION OF THE EXISTING PROPERTY AND THE CONTENT FOR THE EXISTING EQUIPMENT THEREIN.

THE WORD PREMISES AS USED SHALL MEAN AN EXISTING BUILDING AND PREMISES. IT SHALL NOT MEAN NEW CONSTRUCTION AND/OR AN ADDITION TO AN EXISTING BUILDING. LIMITED PREMISES AND LIMITED MAINTENANCE LICENSE SHALL AUTHORIZE A PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION THE RIGHT TO REPAIR AND/OR MAINTAIN EXISTING ELECTRIC WIRES, DEVICES, APPLIANCES AND EQUIPMENT ON THE PREMISES. AN INDIVIDUAL LIMITED PREMISES AND LIMITED MAINTENANCE LICENSE IS REQUIRED FOR EACH ADDRESS.

LIMITED PREMISES AND LIMITED MAINTENANCE LICENSE, AS PROVIDED IN CHAPTER 5-6-10, 5-6-10.1 AND 5-6-14 OF THE GENERAL LAWS, SHALL AUTHORIZE MUNICIPALITIES, SCHOOLS, HOSPITALS, COLLEGES, OR OTHER NON-MANUFACTURING FIRMS OR ENTITIES, WHO REGULARLY EMPLOY ONE (1) OR MORE LICENSED ELECTRICIANS.

(JOURNEYPERSON/CLASS B) THE RIGHT TO REPAIR AND/OR MAINTAIN EXISTING ELECTRIC WIRES, DEVICES, APPLIANCES AND EQUIPMENT ON SAID PREMISE.
