

Judicial Nominating Commission
Tuesday, July 12, 2011
Minutes

Chairperson Herbert J. Brennan, D.O., recognizing there was a quorum present, called the meeting to order at 5:25 p.m. Chairperson Brennan reviewed the application process to those present and indicated the commission had selected seven (7) candidates to be interviewed this evening to fill the vacated Superior Court position of Associate Justice Edwin J. Gale.

Chairperson Brennan welcomed the first candidate, Lynette Joy Labinger, and introduced the commission members. Candidate Labinger was asked to give a brief presentation to the commission after which each commissioner had an opportunity to ask the candidate specific questions.

At the conclusion of the interview, Chairperson Brennan indicated to the candidate there would be a follow-up meeting on Wednesday, July 20, 2011, held in the basement of the Department of Health conference room beginning at 5:30 p.m. He further indicated that each candidate has the opportunity to invite up to two individuals to speak on their behalf for up to five minutes each. At the conclusion of the meeting, the commissioners will vote and three to five candidate's names will be sent on to the Governor for consideration to fill the vacated seat of Associate Justice Edwin J. Gale.

Chairperson Brennan then welcomed Brian A. Goldman to address the commission at approximately 6 p.m. The same process was followed.

The Honorable Pamela Woodcock-Pfeiffer was welcomed and introduced to the commissioners at approximately 6:30 p.m. The same process was followed

Harris K. Weiner was welcomed and introduced to the commissioners at approximately 7 p.m. The same process was followed.

Patricia A. Coyne-Fague was welcomed and introduced to the commissioners at approximately 7:30 p.m. The same process was followed.

Eva-Marie Mancuso was welcomed and introduced to the commissioners at approximately 8 p.m. The same process was followed.

Edward H. Newman was welcomed and introduced to the commissioners at approximately 8:30 p.m. The same process was followed.

All of the above candidates were given the opportunity to address the commission. All of the above candidates were asked questions by the commissioners and were advised of the next step.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 9:07 p.m.
