**MINUTES**

Mrs. Dowling called the meeting to order at 5:37 p.m. at the Department of Administration Building, Second Floor Conference Room B. Rachel DiNezza, Legal Assistant to the Commission, kept the Minutes. Ms. DiNezza called the roll. The following Commissioners were present: Mrs. Dowling, Mrs. Duffy, Mr. Flanagan, Mr. McAuliffe, Mr. Rabideau and Mr. Watchorn. Mrs. Dowling declared that a quorum was present. Mr. Landroche arrived at 5:38 p.m. and Ms. Haynes arrived at 5:43 p.m.

Mrs. Dowling pointed out that the Notice of the Meeting had been properly posted on January 28, 2016 in accordance with the Open Meetings Act. A copy of that Notice is annexed to these Minutes.

On a motion by Mr. McAuliffe and seconded by Mr. Flanagan, it was unanimously voted to approve the Minutes of the January 20, 2016 meeting of the Judicial Nominating Commission.

Mrs. Dowling announced with regret the resignation of Lorraine Lalli as a Commissioner.

Mrs. Dowling welcomed the audience and gave a brief explanation of the public comment process. She then opened the floor for public comment and reminded everyone to keep their remarks to five (5) minutes. The following persons were recognized and heard:

The following individuals also spoke: Tonya McConnell, LICSW, Darlene Allen, Adoption RI and Anne Grant, Parenting Project.

The following individuals were interviewed for the Family Court Chief Judge vacancy: The Honorable Lauren D'Ambra and The Honorable Michael B. Forte.

The Commission Members conducted the voting for the position of Chief Judge on written ballots. After one round of voting, two (2) individuals received the required number of votes. Accordingly, the following names will be forwarded to Governor Gina Raimondo, in alphabetical order, for her consideration, along with copies of their applications, financial information, background investigative reports and letters of recommendation:
