Dr. Box presented the Board with highlights from the New Hampshire Conference he attended. The subject matter of the conference was “Critical Issues in Dentistry”.

Mrs. Gazzola announced the Board’s annual holiday get-together will be held on January 7, 2006 at Pinelli’s North End.

The next meeting of the Board is scheduled for 18 January 2005.

The Chairman called for a motion to adjourn the “Open Session” and enter into “Closed Executive Session” for the purpose of discussing disciplinary matters pursuant to the applicable exceptions of the “Open Meeting Law”, so called of Chapter 42-46-5 sub-division (1) and (4) of the General Laws. Upon motion by Dr. Molak, seconded by Dr. Connor, the Board voted unanimously to enter into “Executive Session” at 9:06 a.m

Sealing of the Closed Executive Minutes

The Chairman called for a motion to seal the minutes of the “Closed Executive Session” of 16 November 2005 meeting pursuant to

Section 42-46 (1) and (2). Upon motion of Mrs. Gazzola, seconded by Dr. Glick, the Board Voted unanimously to seal the minutes.

At this time, the Chairman introduced Dr. Gifford to the Board. Dr. Gifford addressed the Board and an open type forum was conducted. The Board discussed the following topics with the Director: concerns regarding access to dental care, the PG1 Pathway to licensure, and continuing education. The Director advised that the access to dental care issue is actually a budgetary matter. He commended the Board for being pro-active in its opposition of the PG1 Pathway to Licensure and encouraged the Board to continue its efforts to this end. The Director also addressed the issue of continuing education and expressed his opinion that CEU's are not necessarily a reliable measure of a practitioner's competency and audits are not been conducted for any of the professional boards due to the lack of personnel resources. Although the Board members agreed, it was of the opinion that audits should be conducted in that continuing education is mandated and a requirement for licensure.

Upon motion of Dr. Molak, seconded by Mr. Manchester, it was unanimously VOTED by the Board to adjourn the meeting at 10:10 a.m.
