

**R. I. STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS  
MINUTES OF MEETING  
September 11, 2012**

The Rhode Island State Board of Elections convened at 3:32 PM at the Rhode Island Board of Elections, a quorum included, Chairman Frank Rego, Vice-Chairman Richard Pierce, Commissioner Florence Gormley and Commissioner Susan Farmer. Executive Director Robert Kando was also in attendance.

First order of business: Commissioner Farmer moved to approve the minutes for Board of Elections meeting dated 8/11/12 seconded by Commissioner Gormley and passed unanimously.

Next order of business: Executive Director Robert Kando notified the Board that six nursing home voters and one poll worker voted ballots for the wrong voting district and that they were all given the opportunity to cast the correct ballots, and that five nursing home voters and one poll worker have recast the correct ballot. Commissioner Gormley moved to disqualify the ballots from the wrong voting district and include the correctly voted ballots in the mail ballot certification process. Commissioner Farmer seconded the motion, which was then passed unanimously.

Next order of business: At 3:45 PM Commissioner Gormley motion to adjourn was seconded by Commissioner Farmer and passed unanimously.
