**Pasquale Bertoldi, Alliance Concrete Forms-viol. #3572**

**Joseph Sabitoni read the violation:**

**On October 7, 2008, Alliance Concrete Forms, a subcontractor of C & D Construction had five (5) employees, Ed Cruz, Jason Garrepy, William Petrangelo, Vincent Lowell, and Arthur Williams working at the East Providence Senior Center, Waterman Avenue, East Providence RI without OSHA 10 hour Safety Training, for five (5) violations of RIGL 37-23-1-“safety awareness program” at \$500.00 a piece for a total of \$2500.00.**

**Pasquale Bertoldi, Alliance Concrete Forms was sent a letter by certified mail notifying him to appear before the board, Mr. Bertoldi did not show up and the hearing proceeded without him.**

**Glenn Dusablon, Chief Electrical Investigator was sworn in and addressed the board.**

**The board questioned Mr. Dusablon.**

**A motion to make a recommendation to the Director to uphold the fine of \$2500.00 was made by Wayne Coulombe and seconded by Bernard Trembl. Passed unanimously by the board.**

**Discussion of appointing a chief of Safety Awareness, the board agreed to draft a letter to the Governor via the Director of Labor in regard to the importance of the safety issues.
