Discussion: Chris Botts updated the committee on the Pilot Recycling Project. The two agencies that have been participating in the program are the Governor's Commission on Disabilities and the Dept. of Elderly Affairs. One of the main goals of the project was to expand the program to other agencies. As of last week, there are now two new agencies participating in the recycling program, Probation and DEM. With the two agencies, there will be approximately 300 additional employees that will be Recycling.
