**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD**

**CALLED TO ORDER: Chairman Moore, PE called the meeting to order at 9:27 a.m. to commence Board business**

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**(1) Acceptance of the 17 June 2015 minutes of the meetings.**

**Secretary Aldinger made a motion to continue the approval of the 17 June 2015 minutes until next month due to a lack of a quorum. Chairman Moore seconded the motion. The motion passed; two in favor, one absent and two abstained. Voting in favor were; Chairman Moore and Secretary Aldinger. Mr. Duhamel was absent. Ms. Walker and Ms. Charles abstained.**

**(2) EXECUTIVE SESSION**

**Secretary Aldinger made a motion to convene into executive session at 9:58 a.m. pursuant to RI General Laws, Section §42-46(5)(a)(2) for sessions or work sessions pertaining to collective bargaining or litigation and §42-46-(5)(a)(4) for investigative proceedings regarding allegations of civil or criminal misconduct. Chairman Moore seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously, four in favor. Voting in favor were; Chairman Moore, Secretary Aldinger, Ms. Walker and Ms. Charles.**

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**Secretary Aldinger moved to adjourn from executive session and to reconvene to open meeting at 10:47 a.m. pursuant to R.I.G.L. §42-46-4. **(3) Correspondence from David Tuttle, North Carolina Board Counsel**  
**The Board reviewed informational correspondence received from David S. Tuttle, North Carolina Board Counsel regarding Engineering Testimony.**

**(4) Correspondence from Jerry Carter, Chief Executive Officer**  
**The topic of this correspondence was the September 2015 American Association of Engineering Societies (AAES) Newsletter regarding data security and public policy with an emphasis on what societies should be advocating for in regard to public policy.**

**(5) Correspondence from John Ireland**

**Secretary Aldinger made a motion to send a letter to Mr. Ireland**

directing him to review the ABET accreditations website for colleges and universities that have EAC/ABET accredited Fire Protections degrees. If the degree is a TAC degree he will need a Master's Degree from a college or university that has an EAC/ABET BS degree. Ms. Walker seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously, four in favor. Voting in favor were; Chairman Moore, Secretary Aldinger, Ms. Walker and Ms. Charles.

#### **(6) NCEES Annual Meeting**
