

A subcommittee of the Fire Safety Code Board of Appeal & Review met in Conference Room 109 at 260 West Exchange Street, Providence, RI on Wednesday, June 14, 2006 at 9:00 A.M. Present were Chairman Farrell and Commissioners Blackburn, Burlingame and Pearson. Also present were Executive Director Thomas Coffey, Jr. Esq. and Administrative Assistant Desiree Campanini. ADSFM Michael DeMello appeared for the North Providence Fire Marshal's Office for the following properties. The Subcommittee's recommendations will be ratified by the full Board on June 20, 2006. The following appeals were considered.

Appeal #040295: Mr. Anthony Costanzo for the property located at 2026 Smith Street, North Providence. The subcommittee recommended a time variance of 120 days from the date of the decision in which to bring this facility into compliance.

Appeal #020205: 1081 Mineral Spring Avenue, North Providence. Applicant failed to appear. File closed.

Appeal #030152: Lymanville VFW Post for the property located at 354 Fruit Hill Avenue, North Providence. This facility will be re-inspected by the North Providence Fire Marshal's Office. File closed.

Appeal #030221: 19 Volturmo Street, North Providence. Applicant failed to appear. File closed.

Appeal #040270: Ms. Cynthia Holt and Mr. Ronald LaChance for the property located at 60-62 Hurdis Street, North Providence. The subcommittee recommended 120 days from the date of this decision to bring this facility into compliance at the direction and to the satisfaction of the North Providence Fire Marshal's Office.

Appeal # 040276: Mr. William Herendeen for the property located at 1352 Smith Street, North Providence. The subcommittee recommended 120 days from the date of this decision to bring this facility into compliance, at the direction and to the satisfaction of the North Providence Fire Marshal's Office.

Appeal #040340: 258 Woonasquatucket Avenue, North Providence. Applicant failed to appear. File closed.

Appeal #040346: Mr. Joseph Desianta for the property located at 1006 Charles Street, North Providence. The subcommittee recommended a time variance of 120 days from the date of this decision to correct all of the deficiencies at the direction and to the satisfaction of the North Providence Fire Marshal's Office, with the exception of the variance granted for items #4 and #8.

Appeal #040355: Mr. John M. Sayig for the property located at 1621 Smith Street, North Providence. The subcommittee recommended a variance for the bathroom windows providing no obstruction to the

windows and no locks on the bathroom doors. The Applicant was given 120 days from the date of this decision to correct all other deficiencies at the direction and to the satisfaction of the North Providence Fire Marshal's Office.

Appeal #040426: Mr. Anthony W. Albanese for the property located at 1701 Smith Street, North Providence. The subcommittee recommended 120 days from the date of this decision to correct all deficiencies within this facility at the direction and to the satisfaction of the North Providence Fire Marshal's Office.

Appeal #040469: The Salvation Army ARC for the property located at 1895 Smith Street, North Providence. The subcommittee recommended a time variance of 120 days from the date of this decision to correct all deficiencies within this facility at the direction and to the satisfaction of the North Providence Fire Marshal's Office.

Appeal #040475: Mr. Calvin Bailey for the property located at 1910 Smith Street, North Providence. The subcommittee recommended that the North Providence Fire Marshal's Office re-inspect this property. File Closed.
