

**Fire Safety Code Board  
Of Appeal & Review  
Minutes of June 16, 2009 hearing**

**The Rhode Island Fire Safety Code Board of Appeal & Review met at their headquarters located at 1 Regan Court, Varley Building #46, in Cranston, RI on Tuesday, June 16, 2009 at 1:00 P.M. Present were Acting Chairman Newbrook and Commissioners Richard, Preiss, Blackburn, Jackson, Pearson, Walker, Dias and Filippi. Chairman Coutu and Commissioner Jasparro were absent from the hearing. Also present were Executive Director Thomas B. Coffey, Jr. and Deputy Director Carol Marsella. The following cases were heard.**

**APPEAL #060605B: Tara Food Services, for the property located at 4 Blossom Street in West Warwick. ADSFM John Peiczarek and ADSFM Albert Heroux appeared for the West Warwick Fire Marshal's office. Commissioner Blackburn made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Dias, to approve the Applicant's request for one sprinkler zone in his facility, per the conditions outlined in the signed agreement letter between the parties. The motion was unanimous.**

**APPEAL #070001: Mr. Steven R. Costa, for the property located at 175 Taunton Avenue in East Providence. Commissioner Walker recused himself from consideration of this case. ADSFM James Bellamy appeared for the East Providence Fire Marshal's office. Commissioner Pearson made a motion, seconded by Commissioner**

**Richard, to grant the Applicant a time variance of thirty days to submit a plan of action for the correction of the outstanding deficiencies in this facility to the East Providence Fire Marshal's office and an additional 120 days in which to make those corrections. The East Providence Fire Marshal's office is granted the authority to extend the above timeline for good faith efforts being shown by the Applicant. The motion was unanimous.**

**APPEAL #070075: Mr. John Jarrell for the property located at 3120 Pawtucket Avenue in East Providence. Commissioner Walker recused himself from consideration of this case. ADSFM James Bellamy appeared for the East Providence Fire Marshal's office. It was determined that the Applicant would return to the Board on September 1, 2009 with a plan of action for the correction of the outstanding deficiencies in this facility. The motion was unanimous.**

**APPEAL #060912: Mr. Donald Cournoyer, for the property located at 25 Mechanic Street in Woonsocket. Assistant Deputy State Fire Marshals Dunton and Morin appeared for the Woonsocket Fire Marshal's office. Commissioner Pearson made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Jackson, to grant the Applicant a time variance of thirty days to submit plans for the correction of the outstanding deficiencies in this facility and an additional 120 days to make those corrections. The Woonsocket Fire Marshal's office is granted the authority to extend the above timeline for good faith efforts shown by the Applicant. The motion was unanimous.**

**APPEAL #070185: CHILD Inc., for the property located at 23 Cady Street in Coventry. DSFM Christopher Moore appeared for the State Fire Marshal's office. Commissioner Walker made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Filippi, to grant the Applicant a time variance of thirty days in which to submit plans for the correction of the cited sprinkler heads to the State Fire Marshal's office and an additional 120 days in which to make the above corrections. The State Fire Marshal's office is authorized to extend the above timeline for good faith efforts shown by the Applicant. The Applicant is granted a variance, based on structural hardship, for the lack of remoteness of exits on the second floor. The motion was unanimous.**
