

**The Rhode Fire Safety Code Board of Appeal and Review met at its headquarters located at 2 Regan Court, Mathias Building #56, in Cranston, RI on Tuesday June 24, 2014 at 1:00 P.M. Present were Chairman Newbrook and Vice Chairperson Filippi and Commissioners Booth, Thornton, Sylvester, Richard, Pearson and Burlingame. Commissioners Walker, Jackson and Blackburn were absent. Also present were Peter Dennehy, Esq. and Administrative Assistant Desiree Campanini.**

**The following cases were heard.**

**Timothy A. Williamson, for the properties located at:**

**APPEAL #050504D: 1 Webster Knight Drive, West Warwick (West Warwick High School)**

**APPEAL #050505D: 2 Webster Knight Drive, West Warwick (J.F. Deering Middle School)**

**ADSFM James Bobola appeared for the West Warwick Fire Marshal's Office. Commissioner Sylvester made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Thornton, to grant the Applicant a time variance until August 19, 2014 to return to the Board with a written progress report. The motion was unanimous.**

**APPEAL #090022: Warwick Central Baptist Church, for the property located at 3270 Post Road, Warwick. DSFM Cynthia Dehler appeared for the State Fire Marshal's Office. Commissioner Richard made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Pearson, to grant the Applicant a variance which will allow the existing separation and doors to remain as is. The motion was unanimous.**

**APPEAL #110014A, 110015A, 110016A: Mr. Merrit Meyer, for the properties located at 500 Wood Street, Bristol, (Building 1, 2 and 3). Chief Scott Caron and DSFM Octavio Vieira appeared for the State Fire Marshal's Office. Commissioner Sylvester made a motion, seconded by Commissioners Pearson and Booth, to grant the Applicant an additional time variance from a previous decision granted by the Board of one (1) year to continue working on the approved plan of action. As a condition of granting this time variance the Applicant must provide the State Fire Marshal's Office with a written progress report every six (6) months. The Applicant also has to return to the Fire Board with a yearly written progress report in June of 2015. The motion was unanimous.**

**APPEAL #140055: Ms. Linda Rowe Marineau, for the property located at 455 Plainfield Street, Providence. ADSFM Keith Maine appeared for the Providence Fire Marshal's Office. Vice Chairperson Filippi made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Booth to grant the Applicant a time variance of thirty (30) days to submit a plan of action to the Providence Fire Marshal's Office for the upgrades to bring the fire**

**alarm system in this facility into compliance with the fire code and an additional (150) days to implement that plan, with the Providence Fire Marshal's Office authorized to extend the above deadlines for the work being done to fire alarm system, if a good faith effort is being shown by the Applicant. The motion passed with Commissioners Richard, Sylvester and Thornton opposing the vote.**

**APPEAL #140056: Compton Products Company, for the property located at 1160 Mount Pleasant Road, Harrisville. DSFM Michael Macuruso appeared for the State Fire Marshal's Office. ADSFM Norman Manville appeared for the Nasonville Fire Marshal's Office. Commissioner Sylvester made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Thornton, to set up an on-site visit for this property on July 8, 2014. The motion was unanimous.**
