Given the length of his sentence and gravity of his multiple offenses, which reflect a serious pattern of criminal thinking and activity, including the betrayal of public trust, and his oath as a public servant, the Board believes that to parole him at this time in his sentence would undermine the seriousness of these offenses and promote disrespect for the law. We will reconsider him in thirty months (9/2017). Please note Mr. Rickman dissents as he would have reconsidered him in five years.
