The Board denies parole for the following reasons: since his first granted parole in 2002 Mr. Gardiner has committed five new/separate offenses, in two different states, most of which include violent or assaultive behavior. He was on probation at the time he committed the instant armed robbery which the Board assumes traumatized multiple victims who were present at the bank at the time. At the hearing he displayed limited responsibility for his crime. In light of all of this the Board believes he is a risk to reoffend and also believes he should serve more time otherwise parole would depreciate the seriousness of his offense and his lengthy criminal history.
