**Sterile Compounding:**

**FDA Meeting: Cathy Cordy and Patrick Kelly attended a recent FDA meeting in Maryland regarding compounding pharmacies. Representatives from all states were present. Some of the topics discussed were the need for the government to better define “compounding” and “manufacturing” of pharmaceutical preparations; which agency should oversee and inspect compounding pharmacies that may not be manufacturers, but may compound medications for physician offices or institutional stocking; and how to improve communications between federal and state agencies pertaining to this topic.**

**ASRS Letter: The American Society of Retina Specialists sent a letter to the Board expressing their concerns regarding compounding pharmacies in RI being allowed to only compound a medication based on a prescription solely for patients. ASRS would like the Board to consider “an exception to the prescription-only rule to allow compounding pharmacies to provide emergency supplies of select compounded drugs to prescribers”. The Board decided to table the discussion and not respond to the ASRS letter at this time.**
