Meeting was called to order at 9:08 am by Michael St. Martin.

A motion to accept the minutes from the last meeting was made by Michael Newman and seconded by William Riley. Passed unanimously by the board.

Hearings:

1) Dan-Cel Co Inc. (viol#3832) Sebuh Petrosian (rep Dan-Cel Co Inc.) and Pat Luther are sworn in. Mr. Luther read the violation: On September 11, 2009, Dan-Cel Co. Inc., Daniel B. Celluci entered into a contract with Dacon to install plumbing at the Office at the Crossings, 200 Crossings Blvd., Warwick, RI. Daniel B. Cellucci is not a licensed plumber in Rhode Island and Dan-Cel does not have a master plumber within its firm or corporation. Dan-Cel did not obtain a permit for the installation in the city of Warwick. These are violations of RIGL 5-20-8-“practices for which a master license required”, 5-20-12-“firms and corporations engaged in business”, and 5-20-26-“municipal inspectors and installation permits”, for a fine of 500.00 each for a total of \$1500.00. Pat Luther addressed the board. Sebuh Petrosian (representing Dan-Cel) addressed the board. The board questioned Mr. Petrosian. Anthony Carderelli made a motion that violation #3832 did occur, seconded by Michael Raposa. Passed unanimously by the board. Michael Raposa made a motion that the fine of \$1500.00 be upheld, seconded by Richard Mandarini. Passed unanimously by the board.

End of hearing.

Michael Scallon and Robert Petrarca of the Master Plumbers Association were present at the request of the board. Mr. Scallon and Mr. Petrarca addressed the board in regard to record keeping for

apprentice school hours. A brief discussion followed.

Applications were submitted for apprentices; a motion to accept was made by William Riley and seconded by Michael Newman. Passed unanimously by the board.
