The meeting was called to order at 9:03 am by Michael St. Martin.

Hearings:

1.) Jeffrey Kenney (Viol # 3963) was not in attendance. At the end of the hearings a motion was made by Michael Newman to postpone the hearing to assure that Mr. Kenney has been notified, seconded by Larry Giorgi and passed unanimously by the Board.

2.) Mark Siravo (Viol # 3964): Mark Siravo and E. Patrick Luther are sworn in. Mr. Luther read the violation. Date of violation 7/20/10 viol

3964. The name of the violator is Mark Siravo (All Phaze Contractors) 151 Turner Avenue, Cranston, RI 02920. Location of violation: 4W6, Roy Carpenters Beach, South Kingston RI. Violations are RIGL 5-20-8 Practices for which a master's license required and RIGL 5-20-24 Licensed displayed in place of business. On June 20, 2010 RI DLT Investigator E. Patrick Luther observed a advertisement at the above location. The advertisement was for the installation of plumbing connections for cottages to the grey water system at the above location. A call was placed to the 401-524-1890 an individual later identified as Mr. Mark Siravo answered and was made aware that he could not advertise for the connections to the grey water system. Mr. Siravo is not a licensed plumber in RI. No license numbers were listed in the advertisement as required. This is a violation of the above referenced Rhode Island General Laws. Mr. Luther addressed the Board. The Board questions Mr. Luther. Mr. Siravo addressed the Board. The Board questions Mr. Siravo. Discussion continues. Michael Newman made a motion that Violation #3964 did occur, seconded by Larry Giorgi and passed unanimously by the Board. A motion was made by Michael Raposa to uphold the original fine of \$1,000.00, seconded by Richard Mandarini and passed unanimously by the Board.

End of Hearing.

A motion to accept the minutes of last month's meeting was made by Michael Newman and seconded by Anthony Cardarelli and passed

unanimously by the Board.

Other Business:

Michael Contillo petitioned the Board for an early test for the master plumber's exam. The Board questioned Mr. Contillo. Mr. Contillo addressed the Board. The Board has a discussion. Michael Newman made a motion to allow Michael Contillo to test early for the Master Plumber test, seconded by Michael Raposa and passed unanimously by the Board.

A motion to adjourn was made and seconded and passed unanimously by the Board.
