STATE PROPERTIES COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES OF

MARCH 10, 2014

The State Properties Committee met at 10:30 a.m. at the North Kingston Park and Ride located at the Northeast Quadrant of Route 2 (Quaker Lane) and Route 102 (Ten Rod Road) in the Town of North Kingstown. Attendance of the members was taken by roll call and the following members made their presence known: Robert K. Griffith representing the Rhode Island Department of Administration; Richard B. Woolley representing the Rhode Island Department of Attorney General; and Christopher Feisthamel representing the Rhode Island Office of the General Treasurer, Ex-Officio Member. Others present were Paul Carcieri, Attorney Annette Jacques and Robert B. Jackson representing the Rhode Island Department of Transportation and Michael Bestwick from the Town of North Kingstown.

Chairman Renaud stated for the record that the State Properties Committee did have a quorum present to conduct business.

Questions relating to the number of available parking spaces on the existing lot were asked as well as how many spaces could be developed on the adjacent land owned by the Rhode Island Department of Transportation. The current conditions of the lot were also assessed.

At 10:45 a.m. all parties drove approximately .5 miles to the site of

the proposed Park and Ride property. Questions regarding drainage and property lines were asked and answers received.

There being no further business to come before the State Properties Committee, on a motion made by Mr. Griffith and seconded Mr. Woolley, the Committee voted unanimously to adjourn the March 10, 2014, State Properties Committee Meeting at 10:55 a.m.
