MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON MARCH 7, 2007

Approval
Of Minutes: The Commission reviewed the minutes of the meeting held
December 21, 2006
Mr. Harraka moved and Ms. Fournier seconded a motion to accept
the minutes of the meeting held on December 21, 2006.
The motion passed unanimously.

Appeals: No appeals were presented to the Commission for review.

Action: The Commission reviewed and discussed an order from the Sixth
Division District Court of the State of Rhode Island, regarding
Nightingale Metals, Inc. V. Rhode Island Vehicle Value
Commission and Elaine Mondillo, as Tax Assessor for the Town
of Lincoln.

Marcy E. Coleman, Esq. from the Department of Administration –
Division of Legal Services who represented the Commission,
delivered a request from the Town of Lincoln, through their
attorney that asked the Commission to reduce the value of the two
motor vehicles that were the subject of the appeal.

The Commission reviewed the documents relating to the appeal
and to the decision of the court and concluded that since the value
placed on the vehicles was in accordance with Rule 2005 –
Methodology for Determining the Presumptive Value of Motor
Vehicles Subject to the Excise Tax of December 31, 2005,
approved by the Rhode Island Vehicle Value Commission on
December 5, 2005 and filed with the Office of the Secretary of
State on December 14, 2005, the values would remain as stated for
both motor vehicles.

Ms. Fournier moved and Mr. Ereio seconded a motion retain the value of the 2004 International Model 7400 at \$62,025 and to retain the value of the 2003 International Model 7400 at \$54,475 in accordance with Rule 2005 and as published in the State of Rhode Island Vehicle Value Commission 2006 price book.

The motion passed unanimously.

Adjournment: On a motion by Mr. Harraka, seconded by Mr. Ereio, the meeting adjourned at 2:30 pm.
