MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON OCTOBER 18, 2011

Approval
Of Minutes: The Commission reviewed the minutes of the meeting held September 29, 2011. Ms. Barrette moved and Ms. Fournier seconded a motion to accept the minutes of the meeting held on September 29, 2011.
The motion passed unanimously.

Appeals: The Commission reviewed 303 appeals. The Commission has reviewed a total of 884 appeals during 2011. Commission members recuse themselves from acting on appeals from their communities due to a possible conflict of interest.

Mr. Quinn moved and Ms. Fournier seconded a motion to deny appeals that were priced correctly, make appropriate changes to vehicles that were not priced in accordance with the methodology and to return the appeals not priced by the Commission.
The motion passed unanimously.

Action: Mr. Quinn suggested that the Commission send a letter to the Senate President, House Speaker, and the Governor requesting a meeting regarding the valuing of motor vehicles for the coming year. Mr. Quinn questions whether or not the Commission has the authority to change its methodology without being in conflict with state law. Mr. Quinn moved and Ms. Fournier seconded a motion to send the letters.
The motion passed unanimously.

Adjournment: On a motion by Ms. Fournier, seconded by Mr. Quinn., the meeting adjourned at 3:16 p.m.
