BRISTOL HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSION DECISION RE: PASTIME

On April 27, 2006, the Bristol Historic District Commission rendered a decision to deny permission to demolish the Pastime Theater to make way for an addition to the Andrews School. The District fulfilled all prior requests of the HDC; the HDC indicated that we could not come before them again for one year should they decide to table our request, therefore, Mrs. McBride pressed them for a decision.
