Grosvenor and Wilbur E. Yoder.

(2) Vice-Chair Feibelman moved to adjourn from executive session and to reconvene to an open meeting at 2:58 p.m. pursuant to R.I.G.L. §42-46-4. Member Grosvenor seconded. Motion passed, 5-0, five (5) in favor. Voting in favor were Chair David R. Prengaman, Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds, Members John K. Grosvenor and Wilbur E. Yoder.

(5) Vice-Chair Feibelman moved pursuant to RI General Law §42-46-4 that the Board defer disclosure of all votes in executive session until such time as such disclosure would not jeopardize any strategy, negotiation, or investigation undertaken concerning RI General Law §42-46-5(a). Member Grosvenor seconded. Motion passed, 5-0, five (5) in favor. Voting in favor were Chair David R. Prengaman, Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds, Members John K. Grosvenor and Wilbur E. Yoder.

Mr. Warren Ducharme, State Building Code Commission office, told Chair Prengaman that he would call Secretary Ladds or Mrs. Broadfield to reschedule the date and time for the presentation to the Building Officials. Neither Secretary Ladds nor Mrs. Broadfield has received a telephone call. Therefore, Secretary Ladds moved to continue. Vice-Chair Feibelman seconded. Motion passed, 5-0, five

(5) in favor. Voting in favor were Chair David R. Prengaman, Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds, Members John K. Grosvenor and Wilbur E. Yoder.

(2) Review of “Form Letters” signed by the Board Secretary (Batch 11) -

(Certificate of Authorization (COA) Renewal Correction letter-Amended Application Requested)

Member Grosvenor moved to approve the above-named letter. Member Yoder seconded. Motion passed, 5-0, five (5) in favor. Voting in favor were Chair David R. Prengaman, Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds, Members John K. Grosvenor and Wilbur E. Yoder.

(3) Don Sansoucy, P.E., Associate AIA (Request to Register a New Non-Profit Organization)

Present at 1:26 p.m. were: Robert Leach, Don Sansoucy and Mark Oulette

An informational meeting occurred which gave the Board additional information regarding the intended activities of the non-profit organization named The Rhode Island Architects and Engineers Emergency Response Task Force. The main question of those forming the non-profit organization is whether or not the non-profit

organization is required to obtain a Certificate of Authorization (COA) for the practice of architecture in Rhode Island.

Information was provided that the organization will, among other things, allow individuals on behalf of the non-profit organization to perform services such as inspection, assessment and placement of placards on buildings/structures that were subject to a disaster that is declared an emergency by the Governor of Rhode Island. The individuals working on behalf of the non-profit organization will be providing the public a great level of credibility for the services provided. Although the mentioned services may be performed by a variety of professionals including,

architects, contractors, engineers and other trained professionals, the type of work performed together with the name of the entity implies and conveys the impression to the public that the entity is an architectural organization and is competent to perform architectural services. This is not permitted unless the entity has been issued a COA to practice architecture in the State of Rhode Island.

The Board suggested two (2) options. The first option is to obtain a COA. The second option is not obtain a COA and change the name of the entity by removing the word "Architects." By doing so, it does not violate the provisions of RI General Laws §5-1-7(b) by implying or conveying the impression that the entity is an architectural firm or is competent to perform architectural services. The Board provided a

copy of RI General Laws §5-1-16 that affords immunity from civil liability to architects and architectural firms that are duly licensed to practice in Rhode Island under the RI General Laws §5-1-1 et seq. who perform architectural services at the scene of a disaster emergency.

Robert Leach, Don Sansoucy and Mark Oulette left at 2:02 p.m.

After a lengthy discussion, Member Grosvenor moved to applaud their services and that the Board feels very strongly that they are doing a very good thing. The Board does still continue to have a concern of the name and that they must either remove “architects” from the title or file an application to get a Certificate of Authorization (COA) and the Board would be happy to review it or they should refrain from creating this entity that offers architectural services. Attorney DeQuattro will draft this letter for mailing. If it is the concern that they do not want to take on liability, the actions taken by the Architect in a state of emergency is not held liable in accordance with the RI General Laws, Section 5-1-16. Attach this section of law with the response. Close and send a copy to the Board of Registration for Professional Engineers. Member Yoder seconded. Motion passed, 5-0, five (5) in favor. Voting in favor were Chair David R. Prengaman, Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds, Members John K. Grosvenor and Wilbur E. Yoder.

(4) “Technical Amendments to the RI General Laws Chapter 5-1” -

Introduction

“Technical Amendments” were introduced during the last 2010 Legislative Session that did not get acted on. The Board would like to introduce these “Technical Amendments” again in the 2011 Legislative Session. Attorney DeQuattro told the Board that he is waiting to hear from the Governor’s Office as to when the legislation can be introduced. Member Grosvenor moved to continue. Vice-Chair Feibelman seconded. Motion passed, 5-0, five (5) in favor. Voting in favor were Chair David R. Prengaman, Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds, Members John K. Grosvenor and Wilbur E. Yoder.

Vice-Chair Feibelman moved to tell the candidates, Arron Brode and Olga Mesa, that the Board agreed to accept the transfer from the State of California subject to review of their National Council of Architectural Registration Boards (NCARB) files. Member Grosvenor seconded. Member Yoder noted for the record that these candidates both teach at the Rhode Island School of Design (RISD) and were students of his and noted for the record that he does not feel
