**CALLED TO ORDER:** Chair Prengaman called the meeting to order at 1:06 p.m.

### **A. MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD**

(1) Vice-Chair Feibelman moved to approve the open meeting minutes of March 12, 2012 as published. Member Grosvenor seconded. Motion passed, 3-0, three (3) in favor, one (1) abstained and one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Chair David R. Prengaman, Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, and Member John K. Grosvenor. Secretary Christian J. Ladds abstained since he was not at the last meeting and

**Member David L. DeQuattro was absent from this vote.**

**(2) Vice-Chair Feibelman moved to approve and seal the executive session meeting minutes of the March 12, 2012 as published. Member Grosvenor seconded. Motion passed, 3-0, three (3) in favor, one (1) abstained and one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Chair David R. Prengaman, Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, and Member John K. Grosvenor. Secretary Christian J. Ladds abstained since he was not at the last meeting and Member David L. DeQuattro was absent from this vote.**

Secretary Ladds seconded. Motion passed, 4-0, four (4) in favor, one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Chair David R. Prengaman, Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds and Member John K. Grosvenor. Member David L. DeQuattro was absent from this vote.**

**(2) Member Grosvenor moved to adjourn from executive session and to reconvene to an open meeting at 1:38 p.m. pursuant to R.I.G.L. §42-46-4. Secretary Ladds seconded. Motion passed, 4-0, four (4) in favor, one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Chair David R. Prengaman,**

**Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds and Member John K. Grosvenor. Member David L. DeQuattro was absent from this vote.**

**(3) Member Grosvenor moved to seal the executive session and record the votes taken in executive session pursuant to RI General Laws §42-46-4 and §42-46-5. Secretary Ladds seconded. Motion passed, 4-0, four (4) in favor, one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Chair David R. Prengaman, Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds and Member John K. Grosvenor. Member David L. DeQuattro was absent from this vote.**

**(4) Member Grosvenor moved to record the votes taken in executive session in accordance with RI General Laws §42-46-4 as follows: Motions were made to close the following agenda items B, D, and G. **(5) Member Grosvenor moved pursuant to RI General Law §42-46-4 that the Board defer disclosure of all votes in executive session until such time as such disclosure would not jeopardize any strategy, negotiation, or investigation undertaken concerning RI General Law**

**§42-46-5(a). Secretary Ladds seconded. Motion passed, 4-0, four (4) in favor, one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Chair David R. Prengaman, Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds and Member John K. Grosvenor. Member David L. DeQuattro was absent from this vote.**

**(6) In Executive Session closed matters, the vote was four (4) to zero (0), to close. Each vote was unanimous at the time that it was taken with no Board members recused and one (1) Board member absent.**

**(7) In Executive Session pending matters, there are fourteen (14) pending matters, comprised of one (1) investigative matter and thirteen (13) registration matters with no (0) recusals.**

## **C. OLD BUSINESS**

### **(1) Rules and Regulations – (Review for Updating)**

**Mrs. Broadfield provided a “draft” of revisions of the Rules and Regulations. The revisions were incorporated based on items that were discussed at previous Board meetings. After discussion, the Board agreed to the following:**

- Rule 2.7 – added the definition of the “Intern Architect;”**
- Rule 2.12 – revised the definition of “responsible control” in accordance with NCARB Model language.**
- Rule 3.1 - remove the “date” that the Board adopted the “NCARB Direct Registration Program,” since it is only for “history” purposes;**

- **Rule 3.7 – to continue with the Board application approval by Board vote;**
- **Rules 4.1.8 and 4.1.9 – remove “examination language” per NCARB Legal Counsel suggestion as it is unnecessary since 4.1.2 and 4.1.4 require examination passing per NCARB requirements;**
- **Rule 5.3.3 - amended to allow “electronic signature” to read in part as follows: After application of the seal, the architect’s name signature and date shall be hand signed in ink placed across the imprinted seal and dated below the seal. Electronic signature and dating is not permitted;**
- **Rule 5.3.5 – remove “death” in the return of the stamp to the Board per law change;**
- **Rule 5.8 – amended “continuing education” to adopt the new NCARB Model language;**
- **Rule 8 – will be reviewed to compare with NCARB Model language;**
- **Rule 9.12 - adjust the “fees” per 2009 law change - fees were added to the law - suggested to leave the categories in and indicate “as determined by law.”**

**Vice-Chair Feibelman moved to continue for review. Member Grosvenor seconded. Motion passed, 4-0, four (4) in favor, one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Chair David R. Prengaman, Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds and Member John K. Grosvenor. Member David L. DeQuattro was absent from this vote.**

**Chair Prengaman attended as the funded Regional Officer, NECARB Secretary/Treasurer. No other Board members attended. NCARB ran the Business Session and discussed the following:**

- The “draft” resolutions to be acted upon at the Annual Meeting were presented by NCARB. Each state gets one (1) vote. The Board will discuss the “draft” resolutions at the next meeting to determine how it will vote.**

- NCARB urged that anyone receiving the “Practice Analysis Survey” take it as soon as received and also that it be forwarded to anyone possible. Vice-Chair Feibelman told the Board that she completed 95% of it. She then received an error and lost everything. She e-mailed for “help” and was asked what section she was on and has**

**not heard anything back. Mrs. Broadfield will report the incident to NCARB.**

- Regional Director – Margo Jones, Region I, is running in a Contested Election for Secretary;**
- Regional Officers Elected: David R. Prengaman - Chair; Rick Monahan, NH – Vice-Chair; Ed Wolfstein, VT – Secretary/Treasurer; and Chris Williams, NH – Regional Director.**
- The NCARB Voting delegate will be Chair Prengaman.**
- Fall meeting will be held in Vermont.**
- Spring Meeting will be held in Providence. The Regional Director and Chair suggested that the Board coordinate the historic preservation presentation and tour with William McKenzie Woodward, Architect Historian and Edward Sanderson, Honorable AIA, Executive Director of the RI Historic Preservation & Heritage Commission (RIHPHC) as done at the 2011 Fall Meeting**

#### **(4) National Council of Architectural Registration Boards (NCARB)**

- 2012 Annual Meeting – Minneapolis, MN (June 20 -24, 2012)**
- Funding - The National Council of Architectural Registration Boards (NCARB) will fund one (1) delegate of each Board to attend. In addition, NCARB will also fund, by scholarship application, an additional delegate and a Member Board Executive (MBE) of each Board. Mrs. Broadfield submitted the scholarship application and is waiting for approval. Chair Prengaman will be attending as the funded Regional Officer, NECARB Secretary/Treasurer.**
- 2012 Draft Resolutions and Officers – See update above. Chair**

**Prengaman did not feel that any of the “draft” resolutions are controversial. Board members will review and discuss at the next meeting.**

#### **(5) Board Member Appointment**

- **John K. Grosvenor – Requesting re-appointment for a second term. Member Grosvenor’s term expired on April 1, 2012. Member Grosvenor sent a letter of interest of re-appointment and the Board sent a letter endorsing Member Grosvenor to the Governor’s office. As a follow-up, Mrs. Broadfield contacted the Governor’s Office for an update. The Governor’s Office indicated that Member Grosvenor will be re-appointed pending Senate confirmation. Even though Member Grosvenor’s term is expired, he will continue to serve until he is confirmed.**

**Vice-Chair Feibelman moved to continue. Secretary Ladds seconded. Motion passed, 3-0, three (3) in favor, one (1) abstained and one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Chair David R. Prengaman, Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, and Secretary Christian J. Ladds. Member John K. Grosvenor abstained. Member David L. DeQuattro was absent from this vote.**

#### **D. NEW BUSINESS**

**(1) “Nautical Architect” – The Board received an e-mail inquiry addressed to the DBR Director’s Office from Lee Bakalarski questioning if a person who holds himself out as a “Nautical**

**Architect” has the same requirements to meet as a “Professional Engineer” and does a “Nautical Architect” have to be licensed by any state or Rhode Island?**

**Vice-Chair Feibelman moved to draft and send a letter stating that the Board appreciates his concern about this issue. Perhaps this would be something that the legislature might want to consider and repeat the Board’s prior answer which was that the Board has no provision for a “Nautical Architect.” The Board’s law pertains to “buildings” and prohibits anyone from using the word “architect” unless they are registered by the Board as an architect and continue. Secretary Ladds seconded. Motion passed, 4-0, four (4) in favor, one (1) absent.**
