CALLED TO ORDER: Vice-Chair Feibelman called the meeting to

order at 1:15 p.m.

A. MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD

(1) Secretary Ladds moved to approve the open meeting minutes of December 10, 2012 as published. Member Grosvenor seconded. Discussion occurred. Member DeQuattro wanted to clarify the “legislation” item. Member DeQuattro stated that after reading the meeting minutes, the Board tabled the “legislation” item. Member DeQuattro stated that it was his understanding after speaking with Chair Prengaman that that “legislation” had the approval of the Board. Member DeQuattro stated that he does not remember voting on that and that he remembers tabling the item. Vice-Chair Feibelman thought it was approved. Member DeQuattro did not see where it was approved in the December meeting minutes. Member DeQuattro stated that the design competition and fishing was already approved. Member DeQuattro wanted it on record that he is opposed to the legislation regarding design competition and fishing and that he will go before the legislature. Motion passed, 4-0, four (4) in favor, one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds and Members David L. DeQuattro and John K. Grosvenor. Chair David R. Prengaman was absent from this vote.

(2) Secretary Ladds moved to approve and seal the executive session meeting minutes of the December 10, 2012 as published. Member Grosvenor seconded. Motion passed, 4-0, four (4) in favor, one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds and Members David L. DeQuattro and John K.

Grosvenor. Chair David R. Prengaman was absent from this vote.

B. EXECUTIVE SESSION

(1) Secretary Ladds moved to convene into executive session at 1:16 p.m. pursuant to RI General Laws, §42-46-5 (a)(2) for sessions or work sessions pertaining to collective bargaining or litigation and §42-46-5 (a)(4) for investigative proceedings regarding allegations of civil or criminal misconduct. Member Grosvenor seconded. Motion passed, 4-0, four (4) in favor, one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds and Members David L. DeQuattro and John K. Grosvenor. Chair David R. Prengaman was absent from this vote.

(2) Secretary Ladds moved to adjourn from executive session and to reconvene to an open meeting at 2:38 p.m. pursuant to R.I.G.L. §42-46-4. Member Grosvenor seconded. Motion passed, 4-0, four (4) in favor, one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds and Members David L. DeQuattro and John K. Grosvenor. Chair David R. Prengaman was absent from this vote.

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(3) Secretary Ladds moved to seal the executive session and record the votes taken in executive session pursuant to RI General Laws §42-46-4 and §42-46-5. Member Grosvenor seconded. Motion passed, 4-0, four (4) in favor, one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds, Members

David L. DeQuattro and John K. Grosvenor. Chair David R. Prengaman was absent from this vote.

(4) Secretary Ladds moved to record the votes taken in executive session in accordance with RI General Laws §42-46-4 as follows: Motions were made to close the following agenda items C, D, E, F, G, and I. Motions were made to continue the following agenda items A, B, H and new case J. Member Grosvenor seconded. Motion passed, 4-0, four (4) in favor, one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds, Members David L. DeQuattro and John K. Grosvenor. Chair David R. Prengaman was absent from this vote.

(5) Secretary Ladds moved pursuant to RI General Law §42-46-4 that the Board defer disclosure of all votes in executive session until such time as such disclosure would not jeopardize any strategy, negotiation, or investigation undertaken concerning RI General Law §42-46-5(a). Member Grosvenor seconded. Motion passed, 4-0, four (4) in favor, one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds, Members David L. DeQuattro and John K. Grosvenor. Chair David R. Prengaman was absent from this vote.

(6) In Executive Session closed matters, the vote was four (4) to zero (0) to close six (6) matters. Each vote was unanimous at the time that it was taken with one (1) Board member absent.

(7) In Executive Session pending matters, there are four (4) pending matters, comprised of zero (0) investigative matter and four (4) registration matters with zero (0) recusals.

C. OLD BUSINESS

(1) Rules and Regulations – (Review for Updating)

All discussed items were incorporated and are ready for final review. Member Grosvenor moved to continue. Secretary Ladds seconded. During discussion, language was suggested to add to Section 5.4 as follows: “In instances where the Board determines that it is extenuating and mitigating circumstances in the case of a request for renewal or for reinstatement, then the Board may have discretion to exempt the requirements of this section.” Motion passed, 4-0, four (4) in favor, one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds, Members David L. DeQuattro and John K. Grosvenor. Chair David R. Prengaman was absent from this vote.

(2) Rhode Island General Laws – (Design Competition and Fishing)

The “Omnibus bill” was presented without the design competition and fishing as part of it. The “design competition and fishing bill” for Section 5-1-14 was presented separately. Member DeQuattro told the Board that he will lobby against it. Vice-Chair Feibelman asked Member DeQuattro that he represent himself and not the Board.

Attorney Algee will e-mail the most recent version bills to the Board members. DBR incorporated most of the changes that they received from the Boards.

Member DeQuattro moved to continue. Member Grosvenor seconded. Motion passed, 4-0, four (4) in favor, one (1) absent. Voting in favor were Vice-Chair Barbara Feibelman, Secretary Christian J. Ladds, Members David L. DeQuattro and John K. Grosvenor. Chair David R. Prengaman was absent from this vote.
