Old Business

Comprehensive Plan - There were no new developments. A final report will be forthcoming.

Hugh Cole Well bench - Dave called Warren Monument. Ryan has the plaque and will re-glue to the stone by July 1st.

Beautification

Route 114 entrance to Town - Kurt will secure a quart of hunter green stain and stain the posts to the town welcome sign.

Memorial tree at Town Beach - Jane reported that we are still waiting for the bill for the tree and the plaque. Funds will come from the Warren Beautification fund

Fatima Drive Park – We have 15 plants for \$232.50 purchased out of the Earth Day grant. Chuck agreed to get a crew to plant them. Jane will call Chuck to set up a date and time. Dave will purchase a bench for \$150. (Bob recused himself from this discussion.)

Company Street Overlook – Jane contacted Caroline, but she never got back to her. Jane will check again.

Baker Street Overlook – Gloria cleaned it out and will plant it with her granddaughter. Jane made a motion to spend \$50 for this project; Bob seconded it; and all voted in favor.

Warren documentary - Diane is still researching. She will contact the schools to explore getting student involved.

Storm water basins –

Topo maps - Bob wants to meet with the Town planner to get the topo maps. He thinks they already have them.

Deeds – Jane was to check on deeds of properties with retention

ponds; will do next month

Earth Day - Bob turned in bills for gloves, 3 packages of hot dogs, a case of potato chips, a case of water, and a case of juice. He noted that people asked for diet soda. Diane wondered if we need more smaller size shirts. Jane moved we pay all bills, Bob seconded, and all voted in favor of paying the bill of \$582.00.
