

New Business: . Standardized department application form reviewed; companies informed they could add their own logs to top of page.

. Updated membership lists requested to submit to Trust.

. No Smoking new policy in effect March 1st reviewed; posters distributed for stations. Smoking must be outside the stations.

. Knox Box update distributed.

. Chief informed Steve Asselin he had given Bob Sylvia copies of rescue applications, mostly from individuals attending EMT class in Bristol.

Training: . EMT Reimbursements - nothing received from Paul Lopes, Gary Violett, Steve Silva, and Jay Sousa. Anyone currently not doing calls who is in a re-cert class must pay for their own.

. Chief distributed list of Scott re-cert class attendees; all members should have attended. If they missed due to attendance in firefighter class, Chief will hold fit test after class ends. Anyone with a mask must re-certify.

. Emitsburg, MD - for fallen firefighters. Chief stated we will be limited to number for the bus. Everyone will need to pay for themselves. Dates are Oct. 7, 8, and 9.

. Firefighter I and II - Chief waiting for Jerry Bessette from Barrington; Chief wants to do after basic class. Chief said he doesn't think Peter Lamb can do since he is not RI certified. Jim Sousa will ask Phil Simmons if he can do it.

. Norman Blank asked about conducting live burn for end of basic class. Brian Remy said it could be done behind his shop; possible

date Mon., March 21st. Chief will try to get camper to burn.

. Norman said attendance at Wed. night drills has been low. It is supposed to be mandatory for probationary members; Chief wants this announced at all company meetings.

Station Reports: . Chief said could possibly install locks on rescue bay thermostat to help keep fuel cost down.

. Norman Blank asked about oil situation at Station 3. It is Chief's understanding Dudek's will now handle Station 3 only; others will continue to be Santoro. Chief wants Norman Blank to arrange for automatic delivery every 3 weeks; Norman said already done.

. Steve Asselin said he has some new members not doing duty, Bill Enright and Jessica Dansereau; Chief advised him to drop them from roles.

. Steve Asselin informed Chief he purchased medication for head lice; patient transported in on of rescues was infected, so truck needed to be decontaminated.

. Chief asked about Peter Karsch; he informed Board Peter cannot use emergency lights on his personal vehicle when responding to calls.

Leave of Absence: . Kelly O'Brien requested 3 mos due to work schedule and teaching CPR; approved.

. Jared DeMello requested 3 mos; he is probationary member. Leave approved, but his probationary period will be extended upon his return.
