Meeting begins 6:08 PM

John Himlan starts the meeting telling the commission that he had spoke to Kate Fereroff (Lawyer) regarding the remainder of the work that Allstate had to complete but at this point because of the funding they don't want to finish. John says Allstate did the television work during low rainfall and really didn't find anything that would be worth a second look but Woodard & Curran did it when the rainfall was high. Dave Johnson says he doesn't want to get involved by looking at homeowners laterals. John also says in order to re-rate the plant at least 1/2 million gallons would need to be removed. Brian Remy says he had spoken with Angelo Liberti (DEM) and at this point there is no legislation that has been passed regarding homeowners laterals. His suggestion would be when a leaky lateral is found the homeowner should be notified. Mr. Liberti states as long as the sewer dept. is checking for illegal sump pumps and down spouts there is really no

need to check homeowners laterals. Brian says he would like to check other parts of town for instance Child Street area. John Himlan tells Brian that monies that are already appropriated for other areas in town cannot be used in other parts of town. Dave Johnson suggests is there any money left over can it be put towards the Warren Beach. Brian is getting pricing from different contractors regarding putting a whole new sewer line from Beach Street right to the head works of the plant. Dave Komiega questions the catch basins because they empty right on the beach. Brian says that the highway dept. is handling the catch basins. John Himlan questions Brian on what size pipe is he looking at. Brian says either a 30 or 36 inch pipe.

Contract #3 Brian asks Mike Schrader how much money is left? Regarding the warranty testing Mike tells Brian that \$40,000 is being held for that work.

Regarding the facility plan Brian wants to work with Angelo Liberti and Eric Beck from RIDEM on this. Brian would like Woodard & Curran to wrap up everything that is outstanding. He questions the cost to finish and edit the facility plan and send to DEM for comments. Mike says approximately \$15,000. After Dem a public meeting would have to be scheduled.

Dave Komiega submits a letter regarding A. Korey Construction. A copy of the letter will be sent to Bristol Warren Regional School Dept. A Korey up to this point has not paid the fine regarding Hugh Cole

School or responded to any of the letters the next thing is to get Kate Fereroff involved for the collection fo the original \$9500 fine.

Snow plow bids were opened and Alves Landscaping has won the bid. A motion is made to contact him and get a copy of his insurance and explain exactly what is needed to be done.
