Brian Remy brings meeting to order. He turns the meeting over to John Himlan.

John Himlan presents the commission with pay request #5 from Allstate Power Vac. looking for \$62,590. John makes a suggestion to the commission to pay them for 2 of the 3 items. #1 is unused pipe lining materials for Water Street which was \$10,149.20 and also to pay the field rep from Allstate for lateral inspections which was \$1760.00. Brian asked John if the unused material can be used on Market Street. John says there are still some areas on Water Street that is in need. Brian makes a motion to pay Allstate for the above mentioned items and then any unused material that can be used to use it. Dave Johnson seconds it. The third item in question is \$10,149.20 which is for unused pipe lining materials ordered for Water Street. Brian tells

John to hold those monies until the material is installed. William Rabideau seconds it.

Flow metering will be completed on June 13, 2008.

Woodard & Curran is planning an upcoming meeting with DEM to go over the maps showing building inspection summary.

Woodard& Curran planning to schedule public information meeting at a Town Council meeting in July.

Woodard & Curran met withTown Manager Mike Abbuzzi, Dept. of Public Works, Fuss & O'Neil and RI Dept. of Health regarding the Warren Town Beach. Woodard & Curran needs to put together an engineering plan to replace the sewer line in front of the beach. Brian Remy would like also a proposal to slip line the 24" pipe. Mike Schrader tells Brian tahat is a 50 year designlife after slip lining the entire pipe not just sections.

Brian asks John Himlan about the facility plan. Woodard & Curran met with DEM in 12/07 and John sent them a letter in 2/08 but to date have not heard from DEM. Brian says he will get in touch with Angelo Liberti (RIDEM) to find out what the hold up it.

St. Casmir's Church is questioning where to tie in the sewer line for the new condo project that are being built on that property. Brian

says he would like the flow from that project to go to Asselin Street or Market Street not Child Street.

Brian asks John Himlan to get in touch with Tony DeSisto (Sewer Commission Attorney) regarding making changes in the sewer ordinance. Brian would like to add new construction needs to have a check valve. And also, that electronic grease traps need to be installed in new restaurants.

Dave Komiega presents the commission with two invoices Columbus Fan and Allstate Power Vac. William Rabideau and Dave Johnson sign for payment
