**Brian Remy brings meeting to order.**

**First on the agenda is Blount Seafood. Blount Seafood is looking into what they can do to pump approximately 1/5 of their flow to the treatment plant. They submitted two different testing events. They are trying to reduce their flow to the river. Dave Komiega tells them the plant is under a consent order in which we still violate each month. He tells them in 1980 & 1981 Blount was told to remove their discharge. Dave Komiega asks if Blount has a flow limit to the river they say yes but are not in violation what they want to do is try to save money. John Himlan asks if it would be blended with blended with the evaporation water. Brian Remy says he would like to do a walk through and talk to Dem to see if they would agree to taking on the extra flow. They are looking at 20,000 to 22,000 gallons per day just**

**the evaporator would be 14, 000 to 18,000 gallons per day 5 days a week 10 hour days. John Himlan questions them about nutrient information regarding the blended side Ammonia & Phosphorus. Brian tells them after speaking to DEM and Dave Komiega & Eric Komiega do a walk through a discussion will be made and that the commission will let them know of that decision.**

**John Himlan speaks of Contract 3 he tells the commission that the CIP lining for Water and Market Streets have been completed by Allstate.**

**John Himlan presents the commission with the Water Street Sewer Draft Report which has both the replacement and rehabilitation of the Water Street line. To replace the line will be approx. 1.79 million and to rehab the line will be 1.12 million. He needs the commission to review the report and make comments present to the Warren Town Council.**

**The chlorine containment and storage area John is waiting for a letter form Warrens Bond Counsel in order to proceed on the repair of the leaking tank. John has made several requests but to date have not heard from them.**

**Capital budget is on February 28, 2009 at 12:00 PM for the sewer dept. this is the first budget hearing.**

**John Himlan presnets the commission with an invoice through January 16th. The commission signs the bill.**
