Emergency Board of Wardens' Meeting

MOTION: Ferraro made and Cobb seconded a motion to approve the cost of uniforms purchased for the funeral with the understanding that the uniforms become Station property.

Purchase of Uniforms for Funeral: Discussion was held with regard to the fact that members of the Department would be purchasing uniforms in order to all be dressed appropriately for the wake and funeral of Allan LePage. It was agreed that the District would reimburse members for the uniforms with the contingency that once the member is no longer involved with the Fire Department the uniform will become District property.

The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Rose made and Ferraro seconded a motion to accept paying out up to Seven Thousand Five Hundred 00/100 Dollars (\$7,500.00) towards expenses for the wake and funeral of Allan LePage

Wake and Funeral Expenses for Allan LePage: Chief Barrington gave a verbal report regarding the arrangements for Allan LePage as well as a status on the investigation that was ongoing. He highlighted that the community has donated many things, including URI who went above and beyond with assistance and donating facilities, RIPTA, Paul Bailey's Ford, as well as many others there will be a list compiling all the various donations and assistance we received during this very trying time.

The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Rose made and Horton seconded a motion to adjourn the meeting
