Minutes

Call to Order: Warden Sciabarrasi called the KFD Finance Committee Meeting to order at the Kingston Fire Station at 9:15 a.m. Present were KFD Warden Ina Sciabarrasi, URI VP Business Services J. Vernon Wyman, KFD Treasurer Carleen Lefebvre, KFD Chief Nate Barrington and KFD Office Manager Jenifer Madison.

Absent: Director of URI Public Safety Stephen Baker

Information/Comments/Questions from the Public: There was no one from the public present.

Treasurer's Report: Lefebvre presented the report. The members reviewed and approved the report. There was a resolution to put \$1,500 from the Smoke Detector fund into the General fund for Fire Prevention. There were no further comments. CPA Robert Civetti's draft year-end reports were reviewed. Discussion also ensued about the microwave link failure in South Kingstown's radio system that occurred and the immediate need for replacement resulting in an unbudgeted emergency expense. The expense will be split three ways between KFD, Union Fire District, and the Town of South Kingstown. Barrington noted that KFD's share will be expensed through the Capital Projects fund.

Approval of Minutes: The members present reviewed and approved the Minutes of the last meeting on January 22, 2015.
