

BCC Min 2015. 06-10 Barrington Cemetery Commission (App. Jul 8. 2015)
The Barrington Cemetery Commission met on Wednesday, June 10, 2015 at 3:00 PM in the Meeting Room at the Barrington Public Library-Community Center. Present Mr. John A. MacIntyre, Jr., Chair; Mr. Robert Black; Mrs. Sarah P. Small, Secretary of the Commission; Mr. Steve Primiano, liaison to the Town Council; Mr. Enzly Ramsay, Superintendent of Operations; Ms. Susan Taylor, cemetery volunteer.

Mr. MacIntyre called the meeting to order at 3:00 PM. *Agenda Items by number:*

2. Approve the Minutes of March 18, 2015, March 30, 2015 and April 8, 2015 meetings:
Mr. Black moved the approval of the Minutes of the March 18, 2015 Commission meeting. Mr. MacIntyre seconded the motion. Motion carried.
Mr. MacIntyre moved the approval of the Minutes of the March 30, 2015 Meeting with the Town Council, with corrections. Mrs. Small seconded the motion. Motion carried.
Mr. Black moved the approval of the Minutes of the April 8, 2015 Commission meeting. Mr. MacIntyre seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mr. MacIntyre suggested that the Minutes of the May 12, 2015 Commission meeting be approved at the next meeting.

3. Superintendent's Report:

Mr. Ramsay reported that the water has been turned on at the cremation garden.

Mr. Ramsay has attended to the half tree extending toward the Morrell Lot near FC Lot 223W at the top of the Hill.

The Story marker on FC Lot 541 has not been reset and is still leaning.

Mr. Ramsay has applied pre-emergence control of broad-leaf weeds. Because the temperatures have been low, he has been able to apply 3 steps in one application for pest resistant management.

4. Fannin Restoration Work at Tyler Point Cemetery the week of August 10th:

Mr. MacIntyre has arranged with Striper Marina adjoining the cemetery at the end of Tyler Point Road for the Fannins to hook into the Striper's water supply. Mr. Ramsay will provide the hoses and a "portable potty". The Fannins expect that Maureen Bryne of Warwick will volunteer to help with restoration again this year and Mrs. Small will provide the bus schedule/stop information to the Fannins and Ms. Bryne. Mrs. Small is sending details and photos of markers needing restoration work to the Fannins.

5. Eight-grave Lots at Forest Chapel:

Mr. Ramsay has created Forest Chapel Lot 319 as an 8-grave lot. Mr. Ramsay will create others if space allows. The pricelist should be discussed and revised to include the costs of 8-grave lots. The Forest Chapel data is in a CAD format.

A future agenda should include a cemetery survey and preliminary planning for the Commission's George Street property. A topographical survey was done by Mr. Steve Murgo when the property was originally purchased, but the area was radically reconfigured as a result of the recent "swap" with the Town.

6. Procedure for the Commission to “Buy back a grave” when the owner is without a deed: (See Minutes of April 8, 2015 #4.) There was discussion including allowing “first come-first served” to take precedence; the family group to decide; and having all the relatives “sign-off on an agreement” as in any property sale when one individual is to become the sole owner.
