New Application for Review and Recommendation

Past Month's Applications — Review of Zoning Board Decision

Application #3757: John Cumming, III, 28 Jenny's Lane, Barrington, RI 02806, applicant and owner, for permission to remove existing stone terrace, flagstone terrace, small brick walk, lawn area and replant all disturbed areas with native shrubs/perennials. Replace stone terrace with 636 square foot wood deck and install four drywells at corners of existing house for downleaders, Assessor's Plat 25, Lot 251, R-25 District, 17 Riverside Drive, Barrington, RI 02806, requiring relief for being within 200 feet of wetlands/waterbody.
