- 1.) Brian Hunt called the meeting to order at 7:04 PM with a moment to observe the anniversary of the 9/11 attacks.
- 2.) Motion to approve the minutes of August 14, 2013 made by Ed Schottland and seconded by Paul Dennis. Motion passed by Brian Hunt, Anne Chapin, Jay Dwyer, Ben Chwalk, Mike Reuter, Ed Schottland, Paul Dennis and James Forster. Chip Hawkins abstained.
- 3.) Harbor Master's Report: Ray has moved moorings around the perimeter to give more room to dock owners. Steve Terhune of Stanley's Boat Yard said he has no problem with mooring locations relative to Stanley Boat Yard docks. Ray is waiting to hear from Barrington Yacht Club. Ray continues to work on clearing the moorings restricting the channel in the Warren River between Can #1 and Can #23. The Coast Guard has told Warren to move the moorings. Ray asked Brian to write a letter to the Warren Harbor Commission hoping they will relocate the three moorings in a southerly direction. Fishermen on the 114 bridge are an issue, blocking walkers/bicyclists, leaving trash and hooking boats and moorings with their tackle. Brian will write a letter to DOT.
