

**SPECIAL MEETING of the Burrillville Town Council held Monday, November 22, 2011 at 10:00 A.M. in the Town Council Chambers, 105 Harrisville Main St., Harrisville for and within the Town of Burrillville.**

**A) Alcoholic Beverage Licenses: That the following renewals of Alcoholic Beverage Licenses under the provisions of RIGL §3.7 for the period beginning December 1, 2011 and ending November 30, 2012.**
