1. Pledge of Allegiance:

4. Reorganization of the School Committee:

Pursuant to Article IX, Section 11.02 of the Town Charter, the Town Clerk Louise R. Phaneuf, Town Clerk, accepted nominations for Chairperson, Burrillville School Committee. Committeewoman Dorothy Cardon nominated Committeewoman Mary Margaret Karmozyn as Chairwoman. Committeeman Raymond Trinqué made a motion to close nominations. There was no second. Committeewoman Karmozyn declined the nomination. Committeeman Raymond Trinqué withdrew his motion to close nominations. Committeewoman Karmozyn nominated Committeewoman Dorothy Cardon as Chairwoman of the Burrillville School Committee. Committeeman Raymond Trinqué made a motion to close the nominations, seconded by Committeeman John M. Karmozyn. All were in favor. Louise R. Phaneuf, Town Clerk, stated that on a nomination by Committeewoman Mary Margaret Karmozyn, of which all were in favor, Dorothy Cardon was and hereby is elected Chairwoman of the Burrillville School Committee.

The gavel was conveyed to School Committee Chairwoman Dorothy Cardon, who addressed the School Committee. The School Committee adjourned to the American Legion Hall, 103 Harrisville Main St., Harrisville for the conclusion of the reorganization.
