

Regular Meeting of the Burrillville Town Council held Wednesday, May 22, 2013.

The meeting was scheduled for 7:00 P.M. in Council Chambers, Town Building, 105 Harrisville Main St., Harrisville. Due to attendance at the meeting exceeding the capacity of Council Chambers, Council President Nancy F. Binns announced that the meeting would convene at the Burrillville High School Media Center.

13-114 Relative to proposed amendments to the Revised General Ordinances of the Town of Burrillville, Chapter 14 entitled Fire Prevention and Protection, repealing and replacing Sec. 14-1 – Open fires.

NOTES: Notice of the public hearing was duly advertised in the legal section of the Woonsocket Call on May 16, 2013.

A. Comments/Input/Recommendations by Town Manager, Solicitor

and Ordinance Subcommittee.

Michael C. Wood, Town Manager, provided background of the ordinance which he said had been substantially in place since 1972. Mr. Wood reviewed the reasons for the 2012 amendment and indicated that the primary purpose of the current amendment was clarification of the term “cooking fire”.

Councilor Kimberly Brissette Brown, a member of the Ordinance Subcommittee, commented on the legal process and the Council’s intent to preserve equal enjoyment of property by all residents.

Timothy F. Kane, Town Solicitor, reviewed the intent of the proposal, noting the fire districts’ authority in the matter, and suggested that the Town needs an enforcement mechanism.

B. Proponents

Robert Hulton, Eagle Peak Road, spoke in support of the proposal. Mr. Hulton cited health and medical issues, objecting in particular to large fires.

C. Opponents

Speaking in opposition to adoption of the amended ordinance were: Kevin Stockwell of Old Wallum Lake Road, Donison Allen of Lapham Farm Road, Cindy Jette of Centennial Street, Rosemary Nicklow of

Hill Road, Don Howard of Jackson Schoolhouse Road, Raymond Trinqué of Centennial Street, Jaime Roy of Cherry Farm Road and Jerry Labbe of Cherry Farm Road.

Those who opposed the proposal voiced objections to any changes in the ordinance, to provisions that would prohibit campfires and to definitions and certain language of the proposal. There were statements related to the importance of the tradition of campfires in Town, the appropriateness of hand dug fire pits, the role of the fire departments in regulating open fires and the residents' ability to self-manage and work with fire officials. There were concerns related to town wide legislation to address an individual issue.

Town Manager Michael C. Wood and Councilor Kimberly Brissette Brown responded to comments by the public. Councilor Brissette Brown suggested that the proposed ordinance be recommitted to consider changes recommended by the Town Solicitor. On a point of order, Councilor David J. Place objected to Councilor Brissette Brown and Mr. Wood's speaking.

Also speaking in opposition to adoption of the amended ordinance were Anthony Silva of Emerson Road and Sara Fitts of Staghead Drive. Concerns raised related to enforcement, prohibition of campfires and problems related to obtaining permits due to the fire departments hours of operation.

Councilor David J. Place responded to comments by the public.

Also speaking in opposition to adoption of the amended ordinance were Troy Philips, member of the Oakland Mapleville Fire Department and resident of Joslin Road, Joe Dorsey of East Wallum Lake Road, Joe LeBlanc of South Main Street, Lori Plant of Foster Street, Kenneth Putnam Jr. of Wallum Lake Road, Benny Coleman of Town Farm Road and Mike Karmozyn of Chapel Street. Speakers expanded upon topics raised earlier and commented on the use of fire pits, the role of the police and fire department in enforcement, fire pit safety and fire departments rules and regulations.
