

SPECIAL MEETING of the Town Council to be held Monday, November 18, 2013 at 10:00 A.M. in the Council Chamber, Town Building, 105 Harrisville Main St., Harrisville for and within the Town of Burrillville.

Notice of the Special Meeting was duly advertised in the Legal Section of the Woonsocket Call on November 4 and 11, 2013.

Discussion: Michael C. Wood, Town Manager, reported on deficiencies in the applications of Casa Fernandes, Inc., Fun in the Sun Entertainment Center, Inc. and P&B Investments. Mr. Wood indicated that if those licenses were granted by the Town Council they would not be issued by the administration until all deficiencies had been corrected.

No proponents or opponents of any application addressed the Town Council.
