

**Joint Meeting of the Burrillville Town Council and the Burrillville Redevelopment Agency held Tuesday, March 24, 2015 at 7:00 P.M. in the Community Room, Jesse M. Smith Memorial Library, 100 Tinkham Lane, Harrisville, for and within the Town of Burrillville.**

**James A Langlois, Chairman of the Redevelopment Agency, called the meeting to order at 7:06 P.M. Mr. Langlois reviewed the presentation prepared by the Redevelopment Agency for the joint meeting. A copy of the presentation is on file with the record of the meeting.**

Barr reviewed the plans and potential for the downtown Pascoag redevelopment projects. Town Manager, Michael C. Wood, Secretary of the Redevelopment Agency, commented on the joint effort between the Town Council and Redevelopment Agency. There was discussion of efforts that might be needed to succeed in Pascoag and that the outcome would be market driven rather than predesigned by the Town or Agency. Thomas J. Kravitz, Town Planner, reviewed the proposed rail trail master plan.**

**Council President John F. Pacheco III linked redevelopment plans to budget decisions. The Town Council recognized the work of the Redevelopment Agency.**
