

Meeting of the Board of Canvassers, held January 10, 2008 at 6:00 o'clock P.M. in the Burrillville Town Building, Harrisville, RI, for and within the Town of Burrillville.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Robert M. St. Jean, Evelyn M. Levesque and Blanche L. Boisvert

MEMBERS ABSENT: None.

1. Reorganization of the Board of Canvassers.

Evelyn Levesque nominated Robert St. Jean for Chair. The nomination was seconded by Blanche Boisvert. There were no further nominations.

VOTED to elect Robert M. St. Jean Chair. The vote was two in favor, one opposed. Voting in favor were Evelyn Levesque and Blanche Boisvert. Robert St. Jean Voted in opposition.

2. Confirm assignment of polling places for the March 4, 2008 Presidential Preference Primary.

The request had been made to combine voting districts 1 and 2 to vote at the Recreational Center in Pascoag, districts 3 and 4 to vote at the George E. Binns Building in Harrisville, and to have voting district 5 vote at the Oakland-Mapleville Fire Station and voting district 6 vote

at the Nasonville Fire Station. This item was tabled pending approval from the Board of Elections.

3. Discuss poll worker assignments and police detail for the Presidential Preference Primary.

The Board was provided with a list of voters expressing interest in working at the polls and it was determined that letters and applications would be sent to each and appointments would be made at the next meeting. It was also determined that that no police detail would be required for the March election.

4. General discussion of the Election Season.

There was a discussion of the Election Seminar to be held in Warwick on February 4, 2008.

5. Update on NCOA.

Cindy Ketcham explained the National Change of Address program the Elections Division had coordinated with the US Postal Service. Approximately 1,000 questionable addresses had been identified and notices were mailed. To date, more than one half of those identified had been corrected.

6. Other business.

The next meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, January 23rd at 6:30 P.M.
