Mr. Geremia presented the Commission with proposed changes to the Rules & Regulations. Mr. Martin asked the Commission to review the proposed changes and note any questions they have.

Mr. Geremia briefly reviewed a few of the proposed changes such as private developments and pump stations, O&M manuals and fines.

Mr. Kane stated that there are some proposed changes in the Rules and Regulations that will need to be made so that they are consistent with the enabling act. Mr. Kane also stated that currently the enabling act limits the amount for fines. Mr. Kane noted that the limitation for fines may need to be amended in the enabling act.

Mr. Kane suggested a future workshop after the Commission has had time to review the proposed changes. Mr. Wolfe stated that another workshop on the proposed changes to the Rules and Regulations will take place on September 16, 2008 at 9:00 A.M.

Being no further business to come before the Commission, Mr. Rabideau made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Mr. Auclair.
