Approve Minutes for January 20, 2010

Ms. LaRue made a motion to approve the minutes of January 20, 2010. Mr. Marthens seconded and the motion carried.

Act on fees for dirt roads

Discussion ensued changing the fees for some of the dirt roads.

Mike recommended keeping the rates simple for the dirt roads. He suggested a fee structure similar to town roads. The board was

strongly in support of this type of fee structure. The board will ask GIS – Martha Roldan to create a map that would coordinate different colors with state, town and private roads.

Act on Reduction of number of drivers per taxi

Mr. Marthens addressed the board on Sec. 8-166 (d) to change the content to “No more than three (3) persons holding valid New Shoreham chauffeur’s licenses shall drive, operate or be in charge of any taxi in addition to the owner of the taxi license for a total of four (4) drivers. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized to issue to any person who meets the criteria of 8-166(b), who is authorized by a taxi license holder and who has read, understands and signs an acknowledgement of the Town of New Shoreham’s Taxi, Limousine or Charter Bus rules and regulations, with no more than three (3) chauffeurs per license other than the license holder, a New Shoreham chauffeur’s license.

The board discussed approaching the Town Council regarding the above change to Sec. 8-166 (d).

Act on amending ordinance for residency requirements

This item has been tabled after discussion ensued on changing the ordinance for residency requirements.

With no other business to attend to a motion was made by Mr. Marthens and seconded by Ms. LaRue to adjourn at 10:48 a.m. with all in favor.
