

**Conservation Commission Minutes**  
**Tuesday, August 11, 2015**  
**Town Hall Meeting Room, Old Town Rd.**  
**5:30pm**

**Present:** Members: Chair Ned Phillips, Jr., Vice Chair Fred Leeder, David Roosa, and Marea Mott. Absent: Leslie Slate and Donald Littlefield. Also present Administrative Assistant Teresa Chmiel for the recording of the minutes, Alicia and Philip Hammarskjold, Sven Risom, and Marc Tillson were present in the audience.

**Call to Order**

Chair Ned Phillips, Jr. called the regular meeting of the Conservation Commission to order at 5:30pm.

**Application of Philip & Alicia Hammarskjold, for consideration of alteration to wetland on Plat 19, Lot 15-1.**

**Receive /Act on Town Council's directive of July 14, 2015 to refer Hammarskjold back to Conservation Commission.**

This application is being considered again, at the directive from the Town Council.

Scott Rabideau representing the Hammarskjold's presented. Mr. Rabideau explained he wanted to meet with the Conservation Commission to discuss their concerns in a letter that was issued from the Commission to CRMC.

After the Commission listened to the proposed changes; the Commission asked the applicant to return with the following:

- Re-site the location of the dewatering bags containing the dredged material;
- What will be the normal practices to dispose of the dredged material;
- How will the site be protected in the event of a major storm;
- Submit a core sample analysis providing test results of herbicide, pesticide and arsenic;
- Submit a CAT drawing (full scale drawing) of the proposed configuration of the pond;
- Where exactly will the 2,500 cubic yards of organic material be locate, where will be it be stockpiled, spread out, and will snow fencing be installed to surround the material?  
and
- Submit a layout of the landscaping around the pond.

Mr. Phillips, Jr. asked about Pond #2. Mr. Rabideau acknowledged and confirmed that no changes would take place in this pond. The Commission asked for the requested material two

weeks prior to their scheduled meeting. Mr. Rabideau will forward the material to Terri Chmiel for distribution to the Commission.

Mr. Leeder made a motion, seconded by Mr. Phillips, Jr. to defer action until the applicant has submitted the requested material at least two weeks prior to a regular scheduled meeting.
