At a liquor hearing of the Board of License Commissioners in the 2nd floor conference room on Monday, March 21, 2016 at 6:00 P.M.

All members were present.

A report of alleged violation against Back Street Sport Bar RI, 33 Arnold Street, Woonsocket, RI is read by title.

The City Solicitor opened with a list of charges stemming from two separate incidents on February 19th and March 7th, 2016.

President Moreau questioned the use of a minor book and if ID's were checked upon entrance into establishment.

Councilman Gendron asked Ms. Nunez how long she owned/operated establishment.

Atty. Thomas Hanley for the defense stated they will plead guilty and the correct the charges to control the premises and comply with the rules and regulations. He stated Ms. Nunez will increase security from two to four and will retrieve a minor book.

Councilman Gendron asked how long it will take Ms. Nunez to correct violations.

Ms. Nunez stated she will increase security on Thursday thru Sunday nights from 7:00 pm to 1:00 am immediately and will impose the use of a minor book within ten (10) days.

The Solicitor imposed a written warning penalty on all three individual offenses.

A motion was made by Councilman Mancieri seconded by Councilman Jalette to accept plea with corrective actions, a voice vote on same being unanimous.

Upon motion by Councilman Mancieri seconded by Councilman Beauchamp the hearing is hereby adjourned at 6:15 P.M.
