Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Tom Alder at 3:00 p.m. A quorum was present.

The Committee was in attendance to view a presentation by one of the six slated Architectural Firms. This presentation lasted one hour, with the Firm of Jonathan Levi Architects.

Once this presentation was concluded, a short recess was held. During this recess, members of the selection subcommittee convened at a separate meeting to discuss the recommendations they would make to the full committee. The full Committee reconvened, and began the process of ranking the six slated

Architectural Firms. This process yielded the following results:

First place votes: Durkee Brown Viveiros Werenfels Architects – 7 votes

Robinson Green Berreta - 4 votes

Jonathan Levi Architects - 2

votes

(There was one abstention)

Second Place Votes: Jonathan Levi Architects - 8 votes

Robinson Green & Beretta - 5 votes

(There was one abstention)

Third place votes: Robinson Green & Beretta - 7 votes

Newport Collaborative Architects - 5 votes

(There were two abstentions)

Fourth Place Votes: Newport Collaborative Architects - 11 votes

Sacoccio & Associates - 1 vote

(There were two abstentions)

Fifth place Votes: Sacoccio & Associates - 12 votes

(There were two abstentions)

Sixth place Votes: Mount Vernon Group -12 Votes
(There were two abstentions)

The final ranking was as follows:

- 1). Durkee Brown Viveiros Werenfels Architects**
- 2). Jonathan Levi Architects**
- 3). Robinson Green Beretta**
- 4). Newport Collaborative Architects**
- 5). Sacoccio & Associates**
- 6). Mount Vernon Group**

On a motion made by Tom Alder, and seconded by Don Gomez, the Committee unanimously voted to accept this as the final ranking for the slated firms. The sealed bids from the top three firms were to be opened at the Negotiating Committees next scheduled meeting. Negotiations were to commence with Durkee Brown Viveiros & Werenfels as soon as possible.

A motion was made by Tom Alder, and seconded by Don Gomez to adjourn at 5:40
