III. Superintendent's Report

a. Citations

Kristine Donabedian thanked Mr. Yip and congratulated him.

b. Lincoln High School Student Update

Principal McNamara reported it was a pleasure to see Friday's drama production, Broadway Review. He introduced Sonya DaRosa and Torey Cotrone from the drama club. Torey spoke about the fall production "In the Spotlight," stating they did a lot of fundraising this year. Sonya explained they had a lot of songs in the spring production and noted the amount of work on the sets such as the staircase for Phantom of the Opera.

c. Approval of 2011-12 Budget

Superintendent Fortunato reported they made an adjustment of \$611,380 after the town meeting. Deductions included technology hardware at the high school, tuitions, supplies, professional development and energy management services. The budget is now \$47,815,049. She noted the pension reform will have a major impact on next year's budget. Their obligation may be 1.7 million dollars. Motion to approve the adjusted 2011-2012 budget of \$47,815,049 by Varr. Seconded by Lafleur. All in favor. Motion carried 5-0.

d. Rescissions

Motion to approve by Donabedian. Seconded by Lafleur. All in favor. Motion carried 5-0. The superintendent reported 53 were laid off and 19 have been recalled. There may be nine to eleven laid off due to the lower elementary enrollment.

e. School Nurse Teacher Presentation

Mary Anne Mignacca and Cathy Villeneuve introduced all the school nurse teachers. They reviewed their activities over the past year, including new populations and new graduation requirements. They noted there was an increase in office visits and a difference in types of visits, including allergies. They showed photos of the Health Expo in September, the derma scan to check for sun damage in April, school house round up, the Shriners' tab collection, pet therapy and the poster competition.

f. Approval of LHS Early Release Days – 1/6/12 and 5/25/12

g. Approval of Five Year District Wide Technology Plan

Melinda Smith reported they melded three committees. There are two goals, preparing students for the 21st Century careers and transitioning to the partnership for assessment for colleges and careers. That assessment will be given on line to grades 5-12. Mark Gadbois reported they looked at where they are and where they wanted to be, including upgrading the existing network and the wireless side. A major challenge is bringing fiber to the admin building and the high school. He noted the assistance of a grant, Beacon 2.0. Smith reported there are no computer labs in the elementary schools so they are looking at putting the labs in the libraries. The librarians are working with Mark and Angelo Mencucci. She noted they need to develop a comprehensive a K-12 professional development program. They plan to align with the National Technology Plan. A review of the hardware is being done. Motion to approve by Donabedian. Seconded by Roll. All in favor. Motion carried 5-0.

j. Financial Report/Charter Schools Update

Lori Miller reported she is optimistic and still projecting a zero variance. They are watching tuitions even though they will be bringing some students back next year. Charter School tuitions should offset that. They will be overspent but not by a lot. Utilities are looking good.

Miller reported their payroll clerk had a baby and everyone is trying to cover her absence. There may be an adjustment to the budget in July.

Lori Miller reported they requested bids at \$12/hr and \$6/hr with money saved by the vendor going into a scholarship for the program. It was determined the most responsible bidder was McColl Field YMCA. They are offering a free membership for kindergarten students the first year, two free passes to the community pool and in the second option year anyone who joins the day care or enrolls in the program receives two YMCA memberships starting at \$140. The other way the bid was structured was to award for one year and there would be two one year options. Mary Anne Roll suggested they have a report from the Y and feedback from parents. Miller noted they do require monthly reports from the principals. The Superintendent indicated they could have principals send quarterly reports to the school committee.
