- III. Superintendent's Report

Mr. McNamara also recognized Jessica Carrigan, Dory Enright and Kyle Zheng for being invited to participate in the 2012 National Merit Program.

d. Lincoln High School Student Update

Principal McNamara introduced Brianna Locurto, Senior Class President. Brianna reported they held a car wash fund raiser and they run the concession stand at football games. They are looking forward to their senior prom at the Pleasant Valley Country Club in Sutton. Spirit Week is dedicated to the senior class each year. They will also be organizing a senior supper.

e. End of Year Superintendent's Presentation – Central Office Showcase

Superintendent Fortunato read the Mission Statement and spoke of her vision to become a nationally recognized, world class district in the next five years and to be a leading district in Rhode Island in the next three years. She would like to create a learning community comprised of parents, community and business stake holders; have data driven decision making and to have the right person in the right job. They will continue to work together with the staff, offering support with the Dana Center, Response to Intervention, Study Island and provide professional development opportunities, create and monitor the Confucius Team and the Race to the Top. They continue to work with curriculum and to improve student achievement, as well as develop the five year plan for Technology. Superintendent Fortunato noted the success of Rachel's Challenge to promote kindness and stop bullying. She intends to continue the effective allocation of community resources, such as the Northwest Consortium and PTO Liaisons. Superintendent Fortunato commented on the success of full day K and the neighborhood school model. Utilizing technology through newsletters and websites will make it easy to know what is going on in the schools. She stated they lead by example, recognizing the school community and the collaborative efforts with the 3300 students. The Superintendent reiterated the importance of working together.

Melinda Smith talked about the K-12 math, science, K-5 social studies implementation and the Race to the Top scope of work. She noted the importance of the grants, including the academies at the high school in journalism and broadcast, design and engineering, international business and law started with the Perkins grant. This coming year they will add sports marketing and human services. Mark Gadbois talked about advances in technical communication with the enhanced website and Global Connect, the facilities with labs, laptop carts and smart boards. He noted the importance of the Northwest Consortium and the current server utilization. Maryann Struble talked about student services, noting the local special ed advisory group and the increase in parent participation. They expanded support for struggling students through the intervention initiative at the high school and middle school. RTI has been successful and the number of students requiring special education services is going down. Eric Banville highlighted the work of the Safety Committee. Through the Workers' Comp carrier and the Trust they were able to look at the secretarial positions ergonomically. He thanked the principals for their investigation of injuries to prevent further injuries. Banville commented on the poster contest and the quarterly goals and awards through the Trust. Angelo Mencucci reported on last year's capital improvement projects that totaled \$508,040. He noted the savings through the Northwest Consortium on custodial supplies. Mencucci reported on the roof snow removal and how bid requests were sent electronically last year.
