d. Lincoln High School Student Update

Principal McNamara introduced Taylor Flaxington 2012-2013 President of the Student Council.

Taylor explained her goal is to promote school unity, citing Spirit Week and not wanting to exclude anyone. She has been tossing around ideas and intends to promote Rachel's Challenge more.

e. End of Year Superintendent's Presentation – Central Office Showcase

Superintendent Fortunato reiterated the Mission Statement and her 21<sup>st</sup> Century Vision to be a nationally recognized, world class district within the next five years; be a leading school district in RI within three years; nurture a learning community comprised of parents, community and business stakeholders. Through data driven decision making they have new educator evaluations, a study of the standards and teacher induction. They effectively supervise instruction through the leadership team and provide high quality professional development through the Dana Center, Response to Intervention and administrative retreats.

Fortunato highlighted the following:

- Effective Allocation of Community Resources with collaboration with the NW Consortium, monitor education spending and communicate with parents and the public.
- Leading by Example by being a RTT State Convening Team member, RISSA Executive Board member, NRIC Board of Superintendents Vice chair
- Pursuit of Excellence in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century to collect and communicate data about education performance to improve educational decisions and improve policy with modernized district website quarterly district newsletters, ParentLink messaging, revamped elementary websites, highly functional Listservs; communicate with Town Administrator, Budget Board, Town Council, Legislative Delegation; implement the 2.2 million dollar technology plan with districtwide wireless connectivity, elementary library media centers, classroom equipment.

Melinda Smith talked about curriculum instruction and professional development, noting Race To The Top. There will be 150 teachers studying standards. They are also revising the math curriculum K-12, working on ELA curriculum and revising the science curriculum again. The induction of Before the Bell was successful. They had the placement of 31 K-5 student teachers and 19 at the middle and high schools.

Maryann Struble showed photos of students working with wireless laptop carts, smart table. The planetarium is used by the middle school students and they expanded to elementary students. There was a trip to the greenhouse and they got to work with high school students. Students are learning to work collaboratively and can explore career options.

Angelo Mencucci talked about their accomplishments in non-instructional operations. Last year they incorporated \$582,401 in capital improvements. The Northwest Consortium has resulted in savings. They implemented the School Dude Inventory Direct software that has worked very well and look forward to many upgrades to maintenance. Mencucci showed all the improvements made at all of the schools.

Eric Banville from Human Resources highlighted the accomplishments of the Safety Committee. They reviewed 56 accidents resulting in workshops on safety and ergonomics with work station evaluations. They had an occupational therapist review custodian set up of the lunch tables. Mr. Mencucci then inventoried each table and has started replacing the older tables that don't work well. Banville noted they have seen a decrease in worker comp losses.

Melinda Smith filled in for Mark Gadbois whose daughter was graduating from high school. He has been working hard to get all the hardware into the inventory. He has been working on several wireless platforms, primarily the servers to get ready to implement the new technology program. All the data requests from RIDE has been daunting. She thanked the principals for their support.

Lori Miller reported they reconfigured their office so she could be in one room instead of across the hallway. She reported they had a successful audit this year. The budget may have a small positive variance at the end of the year. They centralized the free reduced lunch application process. Another positive was the migration of the technology inventory and the transfer to the School Dude Inventory. Miller also reported on professional accomplishments with being a member of the RIDE data team and President of the RIAS business office and the RIDE Race To The Top.

i. School Lunch Update

Lori Miller reported they won a grant from the USDA Healthier US Schools Challenge for \$2,000 for elementary schools. There was also a Fuel Up to Play grant for \$1,000 for changes in food and equipment. The table hosting program is being expanded to give students and parents a chance to see what happens in the school lunch program.

j. Approval for School Lunch Equipment Purchases

Lori Miller explained they are looking to upgrade the equipment at Lonsdale – a gas/convection oven, a gas burner cooktop and a side-by-side refrigerator, as well as about 20 lunch tables. There should be approximately a \$60,000 positive variance in the lunch program.

k. Approval of USDA Lunch Price Increase

Lori Miller reported on the meal price equity and that they get reimbursed from the federal government. In terms of nutrition requirements of more protein next year they are looking at a five cent increase.

Currently secondary is \$2.30 and elementary is \$2.05.
